Directions for the Event

- Vehicles will enter at the light at Pierce Street and Indiana Avenue, and proceed to the top of the hill, where they will turn left and be prepared to check-in. Vehicles will then follow the driveway to the stop sign at the corner of the driveway and the library. Vehicles will be held at the stop sign and directed by staff when it is their time to turn the corner and proceed to the staging area at the entrance to the campus between the library and gymnasium.
- Each graduating senior will exit his/her vehicle and follow our staff member's directions. Their name will be announced as they step up on to the stage, turn their tassel and a professional photograph will be taken.
- Each graduate will leave the stage and return to his/her vehicle. Vehicles will then exit campus at the service driveway exit onto Indiana Avenue. Right hand turns will be permitted only.

Important Information

- Each student will be allowed one vehicle to enter campus with no more than seven passengers.
- Each student must arrive already wearing their cap, gown and a face covering.
- Only graduating seniors will be able to exit their vehicle.
- Please bring your diploma cover if you would like to hold it during your photograph.
- Parents and participating family members will view their student's ceremony from their vehicle.
- A professional photograph will be taken to be included in our virtual graduation video. A complimentary photograph will be provided for each participating student. Additional photographs will be available for purchase.

Seniors and their families must follow all procedures and directions or they may be asked to not participate.
