II. Action Items

1. Approve minutes from August 28, 2023: Tania Cabeza made a motion to approve the minutes as drafted from the August meeting. Monica Rangel seconded the motion. Motion was carried and minutes were unanimously passed.

III. Discussion/Information

1. School Plan for Student Achievement - review data for Goals 5 & 6
 - a. Basic info:
 - Discussed enrollment 1650 projected and 1486 current(approx) short from what was projected. Declining enrollment is district wide.
 - 20 in home based program
 - Growth in Homeless population in last 3 years
 - Decline in IEP numbers
 - Free & reduced lunch-about 86%
 - b. Goal 5:
 - 21-22 14.5%, raise to about 15-20%, 22-23 increased a bit to 17%
 - District numbers, 21-22 20.6%
 - Similar districts: Jurupa & Val Verde above but near to these districts in percent
 - Release days for math teachers to prep for IM classes & CAASPP, and Blooket subscription.
 - Add professional development options for dept members
 - Suggestions: Delta Math and Knotts math/science field trip, suggest Saturday test prep days before the CAASPP
 - c. Goal 6:
 - From 18.6% to 27.3% on CAASPP
 - Release days for Science teachers to prep and review curriculum.
 - Add professional development options for dept members

 - Release days for learning ELAC and getting support
- b. Parent Engagement & Family Involvement Opportunities
 - Not as good of a turn out but went well for the week of the activities
 - PIQUE-8 classes for parents, if complete a certificate is earned
 - BTSN-couple hundred families this night
 - Honor roll-presentations and families to come to campus and connect

 - a. Learning walks, full release day, 9 teachers participated, how to engage students
 - b. World Language, CTE, and History departments, 2 days of Literacy via AVID, RCOE is presenting. Doing again in January
 - c. RCOE came in to go over some PBIS strategies, Gold status-only school in the district with this status, 8wks w/out student incidents, so far.
 - d. Homecoming Activities-
 - Over 300 students at HC Dance
 - Staff v. Student Dodgeball-Teachers won 3-0
4. Budget Reports by Funding Source
 - a. Remaining budget \$ for Title 1
 - b. Hoping to get \$60,000 rollover for Title 1
 - c. EL-some monies spent and allocated
 - d. LI-63 out of 95 spent, should be for academic improvement
 - e. Site discretion is for most everything else, gift of public funds cannot come out of other budget sections
 - f. PBIS-LI money, In-n-Out truck, pass all your classes...incentivise the behavior
