**Notice of Initial Proposals  
of  
Alvord Unified School District  
to  
California School Employees Association and its Chapter #339**

**October 6, 2022**

Pursuant to Government Code § 3547, the Alvord Unified School District (hereafter “District”) hereby submits its initial proposal to the California School Employees Association and its Chapter #339 (hereafter “Association”) for re-opener contract negotiations.

As a preliminary matter, the District believes that there are many provisions of the current contract that work effectively. That said, the following articles are specific areas that the District wishes to address the negotiations:

**1. ARTICLE XIV: ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER AND FILLING VACANCIES**

The District proposes to modify the length of time required before a vacancy may be filled.

**2. ARTICLE XII: CLASSIFICATION REVIEW**

The District proposes to revisit the classification review process in light of challenges that have arisen since the process was changed in 2020-2021.

The District proposes to maintain the current contract language in all other articles of the Agreement between the District and the Association.

In addition, the District reserves the right to add to, delete from, amend, or modify these proposals during the meeting and negotiating process, as allowed under the Educational Employment Relations Act.
