MINUTES

I. Introductory Procedures

1. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 9:15 a.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance: Lead by Mrs. Carrie Mondt

III. Discussion/Information/Training

1. School Report: Lake Hills Elementary School – Mrs. Carrie Mondt, Principal
Mrs. Mondt presented the following information about Lake Hills Elementary School:
 - There are 105 English Learner students at Lake Hills.
 - 17 students were reclassified last school year and 16 this year, so far.
 - Lake Hills offers many student programs such as AVID Elementary, Hawk Squawk Newspaper, Drama Club, 100 Mile Club, Art Stars, Student Ambassadors and Harmony Boost.
 - Lake Hills encourages parent participation through events such as Bring a Parent to School Day and STEM and Art Nights. Parents are also informed about Reclassification and ELPAC and CAASPP.
2. Reclassification member Input – Ms. Martha Martinez
Ms. Martinez started with a review of information that was previously presented regarding Reclassification Criteria and the interim Language Proficiency Criteria. She highlighted that the reclassification process has not changed, what changed was the criteria used to determine language proficiency. She then presented the updated Reclassification Guidance for 2018-2019 and the interim English Learner Reclassification Criteria for K-3. This will be the same as for grades 4th and above, except DIBELS will be used to verify student's basic skills in English Language Arts. Members provided input on K-3 Reclassification.
3. Local Control and Accountability Plan – Mrs. Lisa Palmer
Mrs. Palmer informed parents about the LCAP Survey and showed a video. She provided the links, in both English and Spanish, to access it. Mrs. Palmer explained that the purpose of this survey is to provide input regarding what parents appreciate about our schools and where parents think we can work on improving. Parents were walked through on how to complete it.
4. Dual Language Immersion (DLI) – Mrs. Catalina Marquez
Mrs. Marquez asked parents to look over the DLI presentation handout. Due to time, this topic will be discussed at a future meeting.
