Mr. Recktenwald indicated that the



school has built a nice culture where students are attending and would like them to have a full time principal.

- Scott Andrews – Mr. Andrews stated that he supports the music and art programs but would like to see more information on the music numbers. Mr. Andrews expressed concern with items J and L on the agenda. Mr. Andrews would like more information on the completed work, who is auditing contracts, are we billing properly and are protocols in place.

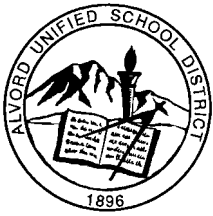
