The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education of the Alvord Unified School District was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by President Kaspereen, in the Board Room of the District Office.

Hearing Session: President Kaspereen extended an invitation to the audience to present matters of concern related to Closed Session items.

- Mr. Kirk Skorpanich, Assistant Superintendent, Human Resources and Student Services, introduced Walter Schwartz as interim Assistant Superintendent until a replacement is found. He will begin in Human Resources on Monday, July 17, 2017, as well as assist with the search for a replacement.
- Mr. Schwartz stated that he was excited and looking forward to working with everyone.

3. Integrated Technology Department Update: Michael Willingham, Director of Integrated Technology presented the Board of Education with an update of the Integrated Technology Department.



The Board adjourned to Closed Session at 4:28 p.m. and reconvened to Open Session at 7:23 p.m. in the Board Room of the District Office.

4. **Ward 6 Update:** Councilman Jim Perry provided an update on recent activities and accomplishments taking place in Ward 6.

- There is a lot of construction on Magnolia and Pierce, the project has been in the works for 4-5 years. Councilman Perry stated it is going to be a business park consisting of 7 different buildings that will be warehouse in appearance. The project probably won't be completed until sometime next year, possibly spring.
- The homeless issue has been discussed many times. There is a Housing First program would provide housing for the homeless throughout the city spreading it throughout the 7 Wards. City Council continues to pursue this program to help get the homeless off the streets.
- The Alvord Cares program – Councilman Perry stated he looks forward to the partnership. He brought a box of food donations for the program provided by his assistant, Diana Medina.

Classified Employee of the Month: Teaching Learning & Professional Development recognized **Virginia Carillo** as the Alvord Unified School District Classified Employee of the Month for July 2017.

6. **Alvord Educational Foundation Presentation: 5 for the Future:** The Alvord Educational Foundation (AEF) raises money each year to be used for Grants and Scholarships to benefit Alvord Unified School District students. Each year, AEF is able to fund field trips, special activities, and give thousands of dollars in scholarships to Alvord Seniors. This is only possible through donations from the staff and community. AEF is encouraging all Board and Cabinet members to join their "5 for the Future" program. AEF's goal is to start at the top and encourage all schools and departments to join.

Leigh Hawkinson, AEA President, stated that at the June 22, 2017 Board Meeting, members of the Board of Education were presented with a Brown Act violation letter by CTA staff. She also provided the Board of Education with a copy of a settlement agreement from previous administration addressing communicating directly with AEA members regarding any topics the association represents members on.

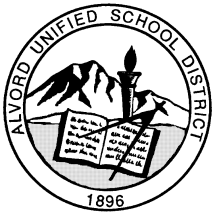
