Hearing Session: President Kaspereen extended an invitation to the audience to present matters of concern related to Closed Session items. No one came forward.

The Board adjourned to Closed Session at 4:01 p.m. and reconvened to Open Session at 7:02 p.m. in the Board Room of the District Office.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was recited by those in attendance.

4. Special Recognitions:

PRESENTATIONS

5. Wellness Program Recognition: Eric Holliday, Director I, Child Nutrition Services, Patti Suppe, Wellness Co-Chair, provided a presentation and also recognized the schools that received awards in regards to the wellness policy. Congratulations to Wells Middle School who received the Gold Award; Orrenmaa, Promenade, Stokoe Elementary and Norte Vista High School received the Silver Award; and La Granada, Valley View Elementary and Hillcrest High Schools received the Bronze Award.

6. CSBA Online Agenda: CSBA staff member Ashley Sawyer provided a webinar presentation to the Board of Education and the Superintendent of their services regarding Agenda Online.

Hearing Session: President Kaspereen extended an invitation to the audience to present matters of concern to the Board.

Leigh Hawkinson, President of Alvord Educators Association, read the following statement: We are proud to be joined by our CTA President, Eric Heins and CTA Board member Sergio Martinez. I find it both disturbing and pathetic that this board does not even acknowledge let alone understand the amazing collaboration and cooperation that has existed since Dr. Salazar has been here. You don't even know or care that we were recognized recently by Stanford, CTA and the statewide Instructional Leadership Corp for our collaborative and outstanding Professional Development program. We presented to others from all over the state. Our current year's Professional Development is even bigger and better and is mostly being presented by our own employees. All of this is saving the District hundreds of thousands of dollars. You seem to have settled back into the old Alvord ways. Bottom of the barrel in salary is fine once again. 11th place in beginning salary is fine with you. No more working to be at least near the top. You would have to give us over a 10 percent raise to be near the top and we're only proposing a 5% which is for last year and this year! Your legacy to this district, our employees and kids will be middle of the road is fine just don't disrupt our personal agendas! Lastly, related to your personal agendas, your interference in matters that you shouldn't be involved in has been and continues to be the biggest dysfunction in our District. You get involved in issues that can be considered illegal negotiations on the side you interfere in issues that circumvent the established procedures in your own board policy. If this continues, we will be forced to file unfair labor practices based on your attempts to side step the association and the negotiations process. You see, we DO have legal recourse when you try to cast AEA aside for your own gain and we will use these legal avenues in all cases! I have already put you on notice about communicating with our members to undermine AEA and some of you are coming dangerously close to being slapped with personal legal action in this regard. It is time to change your ways and get with the program. Recognize the greatness of the work we are doing and set your personal agendas aside and do what is best for our students!

- **Eric Heins**, President, California Teachers Associations – Expressed how excited but disturbed he is to be here. Mr. Heins stated that it doesn't matter if you're a Republican, Democrat, right or left, why would you want to invite crazy in here with so much at stake. Mr. Heins stated that California is facing a teacher shortage that hasn't hit Alvord, but will. Mr. Heins stated that one of the number one reasons teachers leave is lack of administrator support and respect. Mr. Heins stated that it is the Boards job to make sure it doesn't happen in Alvord. It is your job as the Board to stop the bullying and attacks on the teachers. Mr. Heins stated that CTA will be here in force to support the teachers and Union with whatever they need. Mr. Heins would like to challenge the Board to do the following:
 1. Let go of behaviors that wouldn't be allowed in a kindergarten classroom, because if you don't AEA and CTA will be here to hold you accountable.
 2. Stop the attacks on teachers and their Union, stop fighting them, because if you don't AEA and CTA will be here to fight back.
 3. Do what is best for the students and educators in Alvord; focus on learning, work together with your teachers to improve their teaching practice and to improve learning for students here at Alvord. If you do, AEA and CTA will be here to work together with you, to improve the lives of students.
- **Mike Kolonics** - Mr. Kolonics stated that the Board has made comments about the lack of support that our teachers have for our president and people are plotting against her and her job. People are plotting against everyone now days. President Kaspereen people are plotting against your reelection as we speak Mr. Kolonics asks those in attendance to stand and raise banners in support of Leigh Hawkinson.
- **Pye Cornejo** – Ms. Cornejo stated that members have asked her to let the Board know that they have trust and confidence in our Superintendent and Leigh. Ms. Cornejo stated that she believes we need to understand what a teacher is and does, and what they mean to society. Teachers belong to a noble and respected profession. As John Wooden said "I think the teaching profession contributes more to our future than any other single profession." Ms. Cornejo stated that teachers provide society with a wide range of professionals. We are a source of knowledge and moral guidance for our future leaders. We are expected to conduct ourselves in the same manner as is expected of the Board, be respectful, courteous, model good behavior and demonstrate a professional manner. Our Strategic Plan promises to communicate a common vision that is unified regarding district issues. Ms. Cornejo stated we should not put the reputation of Alvord in a negative light nor violate the principles and expectations set forth by Board Policy.
- Kaja Stoll** – Ms. Stoll, stated that integrity is to do the right thing, put aside a personal agenda and put others first. Ms. Stoll indicated that in years past there was no trust between the District and Union, but in the past few years trust has been established. Ms. Stoll stated that without this person we would not have several programs that we have today, like the music program, parent involvement, and a positive national professional development recognition program. We would have no vision.

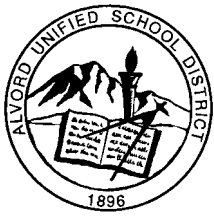
- **Nancy Maki** – Ms. Maki indicated that she has been a Music teacher in the district for 33 years. She stated she is here to protest the cutting of Choir as an elective at La Sierra High School. Ms. Maki stated that two English teachers retired at the end of last year and only one position was restored. Ms. Maki is heartbroken and so are the students. Ms. Maki stated that this is not in keeping with Dr. Salazar's music program.
 - **Jessica Swanson** - Ms. Swanson stated she is here to support Leigh Hawkinson and Ms. Maki. Ms. Swanson thanked everyone who attended the first day of school. Ms. Swanson stated that she is in support of Leigh Hawkinson and the work that she does. Ms. Swanson hopes that your support will help us move forward and stop the negativity. Ms. Swanson stated that the lack of Choir at La Sierra will result in students not having access to a musical orchestra, which is valuable for those who want to continue with a major in music.
 - **Maria Cornejo** – Ms. Cornejo commented about negative postings on social media from Board Member Barragan. Ms. Cornejo stated she is glad the teachers set Mr. Barragan straight regarding the textbook posting. Ms. Cornejo stated that we want better for Alvord and we are working toward bigger and better things, which is why we will be successful in recalling Mr. Barragan.
 - **Gabriela Plascencia** - Ms. Plascencia asked the Board to work with us not against us. Ms. Plascencia stated she will continue to work towards the recall of Mr. Barragan. Ms. Plascencia told the audience to not let Mr. Barragan bully them.
 - **Scott Andrews** – Mr. Andrews stated that he is not a Union, teacher or public employee hater, but he does believe there is a problem with the entire public sector of our economy. Mr. Andrew sated that you can open any newspaper and read a story about how the public sectors pensions and pay is out of control. Mr. Andrews indicated that Alvord is one of the highest paid in the area regarding pay and benefits. Mr. Andrews stated that the Board is severely underpaid and makes about half of what other Boards make. Mr. Andrews stated that negotiations to eliminate the salary of the Union President should be a start. Mr. Andrews proposed to have an increase in the Boards salary.
 - **Doris Gale** – Ms. Gale requested a copy of the budget. Ms. Gale stated that a complete investigation has been completed and Mr. Barragan was cleared of all charges. Ms. Gale stated that to continue the attack is cowardly. Ms. Gale indicated that she hates that some of our teachers are preaching hate; we have enough of that in Washington.
 - **Orquidea Wilcox** – Ms. Wilcox appreciates that the Union and District get along. Ms. Wilcox indicated that we are here for our students and we need to put all of our energy there, when we are fighting students suffer. Ms. Wilcox encouraged everyone to work together and put our differences aside so we can concentrate on what we need to do, which is to empower our students and set a good example.
- Irma Mendez** – Ms. Mendez is disappointed about the La Sierra garden and wood-shop classes being taken away. Ms. Mendez indicated not all students are going to college and we need to help those students too. Ms. Mendez would like to see all students realize their unlimited potential
