The Board adjourned to Closed Session at 4:02 p.m. and reconvened to Open Session at 7:04 p.m. in the Board Room of the District Office.

4. Ward 6 Update: Councilman Jim Perry provided an update on recent activities and accomplishments taking place in Ward 6. Councilman Jim Perry discussed the vacancy in Ward 7, which will be filled by way of City Charter. Interviews will be held on Monday, September 18th by the City Council. Mr. Perry stated on Monday, September 11th, they will be conducting the 3rd Annual 9/11 Day of Recognition Ceremony recognizing first responders and thanking them for their service. Mr. Perry shared that Feeding America is returning to Arlanza Elementary for another school year and he also brought more food and drinks for Alvord Cares program. On September 20th, Mr. Perry will be hosting a Community meeting at Bryant Park at 6:30 covering issues of homeless and housing and updates on other items going on in his Ward.

Hearing Session: President Kaspereen extended an invitation to the audience to present matters of concern to the Board.

- Kaja Stoll – Ms. Stoll discussed the investigation regarding Joseph Barragan, Board Member, and the fiscal impact to the district regarding the Public Records Requests Mr. Barragan has submitted. Ms. Stoll also stated the fundraiser six-part approval process limits the availability to raise funds.
- Mike Kolonics, Teacher, read the following statement: My name is Mike Kolonics. I am a teacher and Vice President of AEA and I am here to address the Alvord Board of Education. Or, what has been recently called the Alvord 5-0. Let me tell you how the name Alvord 5-0 was derived. It is because of the fact that we have noticed that the entire board has been voting 5-0 on many issues like not extending Dr. Salazar's contract. We have also noticed when one member of the board speaks out publically; the other four NEVER publically disagree. This leads to the assumption that the entire Alvord 5-0 agrees with one another. This brings me to reason why I am speaking out tonight. I would like to know why? Why is the Alvord 5-0 allowing our family to dissolve? Why did the

Alvord 5-0 send an email to one of our members calling the teachers of this district “misguided children”? And then state board policy in the same email, highlighting the words...*“We should exercise good judgement when interacting with students and other members of the school community.”* Why did the Alvord 5-0 find the need to use social media to proclaim they are making a public request to see the emails of the teachers in their district? Just request them, why must the Alvord 5-0 make a public spectacle of it? Why did the Alvord 5-0 use the same social media to state that it is Payback Time? Can the Alvord 5-0 please explain what we have done to you, for you to say or “threaten” us with payback? Why is the Alvord 5-0 referencing Fair Gaming your enemies when referring to the teachers in this district? First, when did the Alvord 5-0 decide that teachers in this district were their enemy? Second, I googled Fair Gaming and was a little shocked from what I found. From what I can tell, it involves actions like harassing your enemy and accusing them of wrong doings even if it is not true. There were also references to death threats! Third, I have recently been receiving phone calls from #s I do not know. Is this the Alvord 5-0 beginning their Fair Gaming tactics on me? How does the Alvord 5-0 expect me to be an effective teacher when you are calling me your enemy and threatening me? I am publically stating tonight, I am concerned for my safety, as well as my family’s and that of my fellow co-workers. I used to come up here and say, “I am proud to be a Teacher in the Alvord family.” I am sorry to say that the Alvord 5-0 has bailed on our family. I am still and always will be proud to be a teacher.

- Scott Andrews – Mr. Andrews addressed the comment made regarding the Public Records Requests. He also stated the public has a right to know how their money is spent and how assets they own are being used.
- Tracy Dominguez, grandparent of student at La Granada – Ms. Dominguez discussed her concerns regarding the lack of shade at La Granada Elementary School for students in the heat. She asked the district to consider providing trees or awnings.
- Pye Cornejo – Ms. Cornejo spoke on the Board of Education’s decision to vote down the salary increase requested by the Alvord Educators’ Association. She stated the district will have trouble recruiting the best teachers because teachers will go where they are paid their worth.

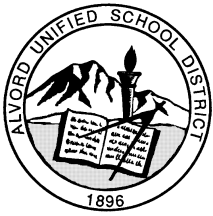
