4. **Ward 6 Update:** Councilman Jim Perry provided the following update on activities and accomplishments in Ward 6:

 - Homeless Families – Councilman Perry and his office are working with local merchants who will be providing clothes for some of the homeless families in the area.
 - 4th of July fireworks will be held at La Sierra Park with the assistance of the Riverside Parks and Recreation Department.

5. **Ward 7 Update:** Councilman John Burnard was unable to attend due to a prior commitment.

6. **Special Recognitions:**
 - a. Certificated Employee of the Month: Joi Huben was selected to represent Instructional Support Services as the Alvord Unified School District Certificated Employee of the Month for June 2016.

 - b. Classified Employee of the Month: Earnie Howard was selected to represent Instructional Support Services as the Alvord Unified School District Classified Employee of the Month for June 2016.

 - c. Ellen Soler Memorial Fund Scholarships for 2015-2016: The Museum Curatorial Team and Debra Johnson, Principal of the Innovative Learning Center, Museum and Exhibit Hall, announced the high school senior art students who were awarded the Ellen Soler Memorial Fund Scholarships for 2015-2016. Students were presented with certificates and monetary awards recognizing their artistic accomplishments.

 - d. Alvord Unified School District Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Council Scholarships for 2015-2016: The Alvord Council Parent Teacher Association and Debra Johnson, Principal Liaison for the Council, awarded the Alvord PTA Scholarships for 2015-2016. Students were presented certificates recognized for their commitment to community service. Awardees received their monetary awards upon registration at their chosen college in the fall.

Presentations/Public Hearings:

7. California School Boards Association (CSBA) Focus on Foster Youth: The CSBA video highlighting social supports that are key in foster youth success was presented.
8. Local Control Accountability Plan Presentation: Virginia Eves, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Support Services, provided a presentation on the Local Control Accountability Plan for 2016-2017, clarified information and answered questions.
9. CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING - Local Control Accountability Plan:
 - Brian Gernertt, President of CSBA Chapter 339, stated that all custodian positions have not been restored and additional Information Technology (IT) staff is desperately needed, the current staff is only big enough to put out fires. In order to support students, teachers and support staff, additional custodians and IT staff need to be hired soon.
 - Leigh Hawkinson, President of AEA, agrees with Brian. Ms. Hawkinson referred to page 10 of the plan and stated that in the original agreement, she was not aware of the additional counselor position for the middle school level, and on page 12 of the plan, Ms. Hawkinson expressed concerns about the teen parent program and stated that the program ended the year with only 3 students enrolled and as of yesterday there are zero students in the program. Ms. Hawkinson thought they had an agreement, if the program did not grow, it would be discontinued.
 - Robert Schwandt, Board Member, spoke with Joi Huben yesterday and expressed concerns related to the presentation not reflecting how much is being added and asked if this is the only hearing where this document is being presented.
 - Virginia Eves, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Support Services, clarified that the presentation has been shared with several groups and the information is also posted on the District website.
10. 2016-2017 Proposed Budget Presentation: Ami Shackelford, Chief Financial Officer, provided a presentation and overview of the 2016-2017 Budget, clarified information and answered questions.
11. CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING – 2016-2017 Proposed Budget:
 - Leigh Hawkinson, President of AEA, reminded the Board that the figures shared today are not the true figures until the unaudited actuals come out and stated that she continues to be frustrated that these figures are treated like facts. There will be significant funds left over, just as there has been since 2011-2012. Ms. Hawkinson stated that 80 million dollars has still not been accounted for. Ms. Hawkinson requested that the Board remember and review the figures you've seen tonight and then compare them to what you see in the unaudited actuals. Ms. Hawkinson stated that the District needs to stop listening to School Services of California's "the sky is falling" ongoing message and keep things in perspective.

28. District English Learners Advisory Committee Minutes Review: The District English Learners Advisory Committee Minutes were reviewed.

Board/Superintendent Comments:

Robert Schwandt ~ Mr. Schwandt highlighted the donations listed on tonight's agenda and commended the donors for their continued support. Mr. Schwandt recognized Katia Rodriguez, La Sierra High School Art Student, who won the Congressional Art Contest. Katia will have her artwork displayed at the Capital in Washington, D.C. Mr. Schwandt stated that there are great things going on in the District that need to be highlighted. Mr. Schwandt recently attended the Governor's May Revise and stated that Charter Schools continue to grow and are gaining momentum, so public schools need to be competitive and as a Board, there is a need to focus on what being competitive means to Alvord. Mr. Schwandt stated that they also learned that the average reserve is 13% and there may be a downturn in funding coming making it necessary to ensure a balance in the District's reserve. Mr. Schwandt referred to the Personnel Order and stated that Extra Duty Pay at the high school level needs to be looked at. Items related to Information Technology (IT) are ongoing items on the agenda and the Board needs to know how much we've spent and what more is needed. Mr. Schwandt considered requesting that the IT items be pulled; however, he thought he would request the information one more time. Regarding the Recommendation to Deny Expulsion Cases, with 126 expulsion cases listed on tonight's agenda, results in a loss for the student's educational wellbeing and a loss of ADA. Mr. Schwandt encourages staff to look into this and see what can be done to bring those students back.

Julie A. Moreno ~ Mrs. Moreno stated that the graduations and promotions were amazing and she commended all the support staff who make them happen, including Kevin. Mrs. Moreno thanked Kirk and his team for doing a great job on the employee guide, and stated that she can now confidently tell people to come to Alvord. Mrs. Moreno is constantly amazed by staff and students and she is proud to be a part of the Alvord District.
