Alvord Unified School District's Literacy Plan: Dr. Salazar spoke about the five needs of a Literacy Plan, commented on the large teacher involvement in Alvord's plan and introduced Jackie Casillas and Jennifer Shriver who lead the District's Literacy Team. Mrs. Casillas, Mrs. Shriver and members of the Literacy Team spoke regarding the comprehensive work of the Alvord Literacy Plan, and led the Board through the contents of the District's Literacy Plan.

Art Kaspereen, Carolyn Wilson, and Julie Moreno expressed their appreciation to the District's Literacy Team and commented on how excited they are about the positive effect this will have on District students. Robert Schwandt thanked Dr. Salazar for his leadership on this important project and asked for clarification regarding how the students were selected for participation on this project and how much of a change this will be for our teachers. Jackie Casillas and Jennifer Shriver explained the selection process, the work that was done over the year to ensure the growth in these students, that this will be the primary focus of professional development offerings next year and that literacy is now embedded in the new frameworks and standards.

- Julie Moreno asked how the current complaint system isn't handling the complaints.
- Mr. Barragan stated that this would eliminate complaints coming to Board Members and would allow a venue for a complaint against the Board. He also feels this would give the Board a secretary to meet their needs. He explained that the Office would require 3 positions, Senior Executive Assistant, Ombudsman and Intergovernmental Affairs Specialist.
- Robert Schwandt feels that everything referred to in Mr. Barragan's proposal are currently being done by District staff.
- Mr. Barragan feels that this will pull those duties together into one office.
- Mr. Schwandt would like to have feedback from the HR staff and the Superintendent's office, since their staffs currently handle these duties.
- Art Kaspereen stated that he currently goes to the appropriate manager to handle any concerns he receives. He would rather go directly to the appropriate manager than keep the Board/Superintendent out of the process, and he feels that there is currently a position in the Superintendent's office that handles the Board's calendars and needs.
- Mr. Barragan suggested bringing this item back for more detailed discussion.
- Dr. Salazar stated that he could gather further information from San Diego Unified School District regarding what they have in place.
- Scott Andrews feels that this is a perception issue and that it would give staff and the public a feeling of transparency. He feels that the requested positions could be filled by moving current District staff around.
- Daniel Bartlett commented that the research he was able to do on this showed that Districts currently using this type of office are super large districts. He feels that this will keep the public away from the Board.
- Mr. Barragan offered several smaller sized districts that currently have this office. He feels that this will not keep issues away from the Board, and feels that these duties need to be centralized.
