- Scott Andrews stated he attended the Novi Family Showcase and was impressed by the event and turnout. Mr. Andrews also attended several LCAP workshops and a Town Hall Meeting and was not impressed. Mr. Andrew indicated that the parents were railroaded through the LCAP meeting with little input and the Town Hall meeting was a workshop and a celebration of staff, which was deserved, but no recognition was made to the students, families or community members that attended. **Hearing Session**: President Kaspereen extended an invitation to the audience to present matters of concern to the Board. The following individuals came forward:

**Hearing Session**

- Tracy Allen commented on the Equality in the district and how she was misled by the Human Resources Department and AEA. Ms. Allen indicated that she has faced discrimination, slander, prejudice and racism and is a victim. Ms. Allen stated she is a living witness to the injustice at La Sierra High School and was never given a fair and equal opportunity to educate her students. Ms. Allen has requested that the district accept her letter of resignation and allow her to move on as an educator.
- Desiree Morgan stated that Ms. Allen is wonderful and exceptional teacher. Ms. Morgan stated that her son was assaulted last year by an Administrator at La Sierra High School. Ms. Morgan stated that the administrator accused her son of having drugs in his backpack. Ms. Morgan stated that nothing was done about the incident until this current school. Ms. Morgan stated that her son was assaulted again by a Coach/Campus Supervisor at La Sierra

- High School a month ago. He was pulled out of class while trying to give a statement regarding a fight he witnessed. Ms. Morgan stated that her son has
- not been to school since March 9<sup>th</sup> because he is afraid for his life. Ms. Morgan indicated that she called and requested a copy of the incident report but that request has not been provided. Ms. Morgan stated that Ms. Allen is the first teacher who has been able to teach her son and it is a tragedy what has happened to her.
- Christopher Morgan stated that the teacher told him to get out of the class and then got in his face and pushed him. Christopher stated that he almost fell.
- Leigh Hawkinson stated that Joseph misquoted salary information, our salaries are 52,000 not 99,000 a year. Ms. Hawkinson would like to know if Mr. Barragan reimbursed the district for the \$9.00 bottle of water he charge from the mini bar at the CSBA conference and the \$70.00 per night upgraded room that was charged to the district. Ms. Hawkinson commented about the Public Records Request and asked if any of these statements include meals that Mr. Barragan has benefited from. Ms. Hawkinson will be making a request to know how much equipment Mr. Barragan has received from the district regarding computers and printers.
- Gina Gonzalez, Parent and member of the Norte Vista Boosters Club thanked Dr. Salazar and Mr. Barragan for all of their help. Ms. Gonzalez thanked Dr. Salazar for the money to purchase new uniforms and Mr. Barragan for helping her raise funds and obtain a non-profit number. Ms. Gonzalez was happy to announce that enough donations were raised to buy a trailer for the Band Program.

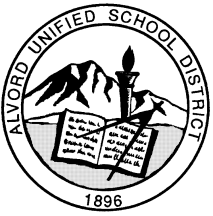

Mrs. Wilson invited everyone to attend their Alvord Cares Meetings. Mrs. Wilson applauded the Corona Police Department for meeting with the Promenade Principal every Friday to see how they can assist the school.

**Robert Schwandt** – Mr. Schwandt recognized and thanked the Collett Staff who raised \$3,800.00 at the Friendship Carnival. Mr. Schwandt recognized Altura Credit Union's donation of \$6,000.00 and AEA's donation for \$5,000.00 to help with the Retirement Dinner and Years-of-Service Events.
