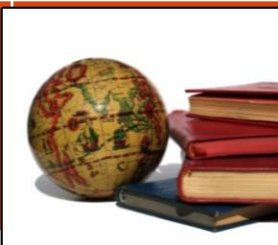

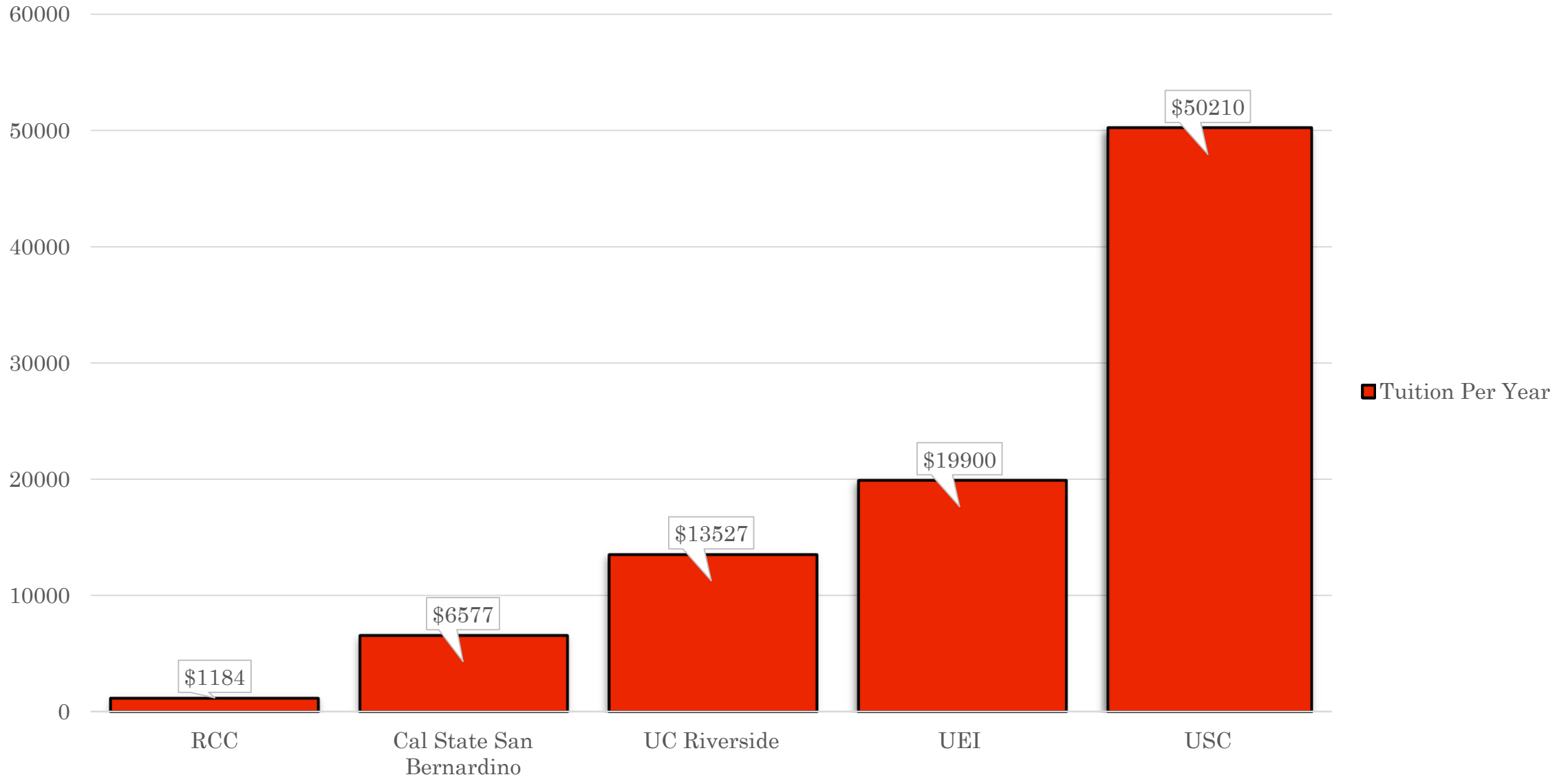

RCC College Promise

- For 1,500 eligible students, RCC will offer a tuition-free education!
- Requirements:
 - Attend Promise Workshops/Events
 - Submit FAFSA or CA Dream Application each year
 - Be committed to be a full-time student
 - Maintain a 2.0GPA
- You get:
 - Priority Registration
 - Tuition and fees paid for 2 years!
 - Your own Educational Advisor
 - Textbook Stipend
- How to Apply
 - Eligible students will be invited to apply via RCC email- Spring 2020



Concurrent Enrollment at RCC



- High school students may attend Riverside City College if they demonstrate college readiness.
- Interested high school students must meet **ALL** of the following requirements:
 - Be at least sixteen years of age **OR** have completed tenth grade
 - Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
 - Attend high school at least a minimum day
- **Cost:** Just Pay Student Services Fees \$40

Important Tips & Tricks

- **Appointment to Register:** means you can begin registering for classes online
- **Books:** A list of your required books are available in MyPortal
- **Parking Permit:** Purchase on line through MyPortal
- **RCC School ID:** Once you have registered for classes you can take your picture for your school ID
- **Waitlisted Classes:** Print out schedule! Use this to show up the first day of class
