  - Staff discussed the purpose of ATP, reviewed draft of site action plan that includes goals and tentative events.
  - Team agreed that ATP purpose includes:
    - Increased parent involvement--including new opportunities/programs
    - Creating a welcoming, inclusive campus community
    - Increased social emotional learning opportunities for students/families
- Parent Recruitment Plan
  - A list of potential parents interested in participating in ATP was created after BTSN.
    Next steps:
    - ATP team members will connect and invite parents interested in ATP prior to Oct meeting
    - Mandy is coordinating and facilitating our Watch DOG program for this year
- Preliminary Event Planning:
  - o Family Nights
    - 3 events
    - Dates:
      - Weds, Nov 9, 2022 Family STEAM Night
      - Thurs March 2, 2023 Family Literacy Night
      - Thurs April 20, 2023 Family STEAM Night
    - Times: 6-7pm
    - Format
      - Possible hybrid of in person and virtual options
      - Depending on teacher interest--sessions can be open ended where families can come and go anytime during the event or timed sessions which will be capped at a certain number of participants
      - If PTO begins again--we can possible have PTO sell food/drinks before event begins
  - Storybook Parade
    - Oct 31
    - Students may wear costumes that align with a character from any story
    - Students will walk parade route on blacktop
      - All students will walk in parade even if not in costume
    - Parents will be invited to watch the parade
    - There will be an alternate activity for any students who choose not to participate in the event (religious reasons etc)

- Ideas:
  - Grade level projects that are created with students/parents during event
  - Grade level projects that are completed at home and displayed for viewing during event

  - Event may be in person with physical boards instead of virtual projects
  - We may consider a science club where facilitator supports 4th/5th grade students after school (pending district clarification of expectations)

  - March 6-10
  - Pending--vehicle event March 7th (pending availability of vehicles)
  - Format--guest speakers with grade level assigned day/time
- Running Rockets
  - Anticipated start of the club in the fall
- Other Events/Activities to Explore
  - College Events--invite each local college to come to site for one activity/event each quarter (UCR, RCC, CBU, LSU)
  - Museum--display grade level, site projects for community and class visits
  - Monthly READING Day--invite parents on campus to read once per month for 15-20 minutes
- Family Resource Room (FRC)
  - Long term goals include:
    - A functional space for parents and community members that includes kiddy corner, parent resources (brochures, information and technologyO
    - Ongoing use for parent meetings
    - Parent Academy classes for ELA, math, SEL
