- ATP Action Plan 2022-2023
 - Team reviewed and discussed our action plan.

 - Focus will be exploring Riverside
 - Star will present different challenges each month
 - Teachers will:

- Promote and share event details with parents
 - Encourage students to participate
 - Will make digital flyers prior to the event so teachers can communicate with families
- Watch DOGS
 - Mandy has organized the program
 - We have at least 1 Watch DOG every day in Oct
 - Watch DOGS are supporting morning arrival and facilitating games during recess (ie. Playworks, basketball referee etc)
 - Will be receiving Watch DOG shirts soon
- Monthly READING Time
 - Team will continue to explore this activity and consider when is the best time to implement.
 - Team discussed possible event names
 - Dive Into a Good Book Day
 - Sailing on a Sea of Books Day
- Other Ideas and next steps for our team:

 - Erica will reach out to Choir to see if they have a holiday performance planned for December
 - David will contact teachers with request for any parents who want to be involved in ATP
